At the outset of the meeting the Collector North Goa welcomed all the officials.

**Agenda Item No. 1:**

Regarding Transportation facility for school children in Honda area.

The Collector North Goa inquired with the Deputy Director, North Education Zone, Education Department and the Managing Director, Kadamba Transport Corporation Ltd. regarding the list of buses. The Deputy Director, North Education Zone, Education Department also provided the list of area wise number of students in the mining affected area (Enclosed as **Annexure-A**). The Managing Director, Kadamba Transport Corporation Ltd. also stressed that the capacity of the bus needs to be taken into consideration. The



Deputy Director, North Education Zone, Education Department stated that the bus for school can start early in the morning.

The Member Secretary North Goa District Mineral foundation stated that they may seek a week's time from the High Court for starting the transportation facility for school children in Honda area. The Managing Director, Kadamba Transport Corporation Ltd. stated that the Kadamba Transport Corporation Ltd will work out the route as well as make provision at the earliest if possible for school going children from Sonshi to Honda School and Honda High School. He also stated that there is 80 percent concession given for school going children for transport facility. The other list provided by the Education Department which is annexed as **Annexure-A** herewith will be looked into.

The Collector North Goa and Member Secretary North Goa District Mineral foundation in principle approved Transportation facility for school children in Honda, Sonshi area.

**Agenda Item No. 2:**

Drinking Water Supply in the mining affected areas of North Goa District.

The EE, PWD also submitted the files regarding the revised estimates for supply of drinking water by water tanker in the mining affected areas of North Goa District for six months.

The Collector North Goa and Member Secretary North Goa District Mineral foundation in principle approved Supply of drinking water through water tanker in the mining affected areas of North Goa District for six months. The District Collector said that there must be a permanent solution to drinking water in the affected area and ordered the EE, PWD- Bicholim, to examine the proposal and put up at earliest.

**Agenda Item No. 3:**

Supply of Water for Agriculture in the mining affected areas of North Goa District.

The Member Secretary North Goa District Mineral foundation directed the EE, WRD to submit in writing the details of the initial requirement of funds whether 30% or 40% of the total estimated amount for six months so that the sanction order can be issued.

The Collector North Goa and Member Secretary North Goa District Mineral foundation in principle approved supply of water for agriculture in mining affected area in the North Goa District for six months for a revised estimated amount.

**Agenda Item No. 3:**


Any Other issues with permission of the Chair.
