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CORRIGENDUM

Subject: E-auction Policy for Dump Handling in the State of Goa.

In continuation to point no. 8 of the E-auction policy for dump handling bearing no. 03/40/2024/technical/mines/2777 dated 17/12/2024, the following clauses are added to point no. 8 of the said policy.

8. The Successful Bidder should prepare and submit to the DMG within a period of 180 days from the date he was declared a Successful Bidder or within such extended period as may be permitted by the DMG, a proper plan of handling dump, which should include the manner in which the dump will be processed and transported and should also include details of disposal of waste material generated in the process.

The Successful Bidders should prepare a waste material disposal plan as per MMDR Act and Rules made therein, MOEFCC notifications & Guidelines of Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education (ICFRE) etc. and submit the same to the department within the period specified above. Such waste disposal plan should contain estimates/cost of such waste disposal. The department will assess/examine the waste disposal plan and the estimates/cost of handling the waste material, and if found to be in the order the department will approve the same. The Successful Bidder shall submit Bank Guarantee equivalent to the estimates/cost of handling the waste as specified in the waste handling plan. Such Bank Guarantee should be submitted at the time of upfront payment and will be retained by the department until the waste generated is handle scientifically. The Bank Guarantee will be returned only when the waste is disposed of scientifically as per the approved plan. The bidder should also submit an affidavit along with technical bid in prescribed format incorporating the details of the disposal of the waste.

The above provision will be applicable to all the Dumps which are put for auction vide advertisement dated 18/12/2024. Other terms and condition of the E-auction policy remains unchanged.
