Sirs,

While the Govt has made announcements of providing bio-toilets to households who do not have toilets, we do not know when and whether this will actually happen.

In the meanwhile because of this announcement, people in the interiors are living in the hope of a free toilet, and are not willing to build their own toilets. And continue to do defecate in the open.

Secondly, my grass-root working experience sees that a whole lot of toilets provided to villagers many years ago under a Govt scheme, are lying unused for minor reasons - doors/latches/roofs/some inner toilet parts, etc broken, some choke-ups, etc. What these toilets basically need is these minor repairs, which will not cost much. I would like to suggest to you Sirs, to consider taking up the repair work of these toilets, by involving local skilled workers/youth by way of community participation. In addition, some awareness activities and encouragement will go a long way in putting back these unused toilets in use, and will thus prevent the previous precious investments and now unused resources of the Govt from going waste. Now that both the District Collectors have been made the custodians of the District Mineral Fund, I am hopeful that some part of the funds will be used judiciously for repairing these toilets, so that it will also help in the nation's mission of Swaccha Bharat.

In response to your public notice vide CI/ADVT/44/2013 appearing in the local press, Gomatak Baal Shikshan Parishad (Reg. No. 328/Goa/2007) hereby submit a proposal for Quality Improvement in Early Childhood Education Project with request to consider the same under District Mineral Foundation Funds.

This Parishad functioning in Goa since 2006 has the early childhood education (0 - 8 yrs age group) as its focus. area It is formed and guided by the experienced teachers with close and continuous association with international organizations such as Shri Aurobindo Society in Puducherry and Swami Vivekanand Kendra in Kanyakumari, where research and experimentation in education is a way of life. This stage involving informal educational training forms the foundation of education and life of an individual. Implementing the scientific practices based on recent research and modern thinking on learning and development involves constant support, training inputs and assessment, supplemented with community awareness and capacity building for Anganwadi functionaries. Parishad activities on these lines have filled the gap in 'education-focused training' to anganwadi workers. The stress on practical aspect is the speciality of the training imparted.

A well laid out plan for training, supervision, monitoring and evaluation has been tried and tested over the past seven years by the Parishad in association with Mineral Foundation of Goa and Directorate of Women and Child Development. Having received positive response from all stake holders, followed by consistent request to scale it up to cover larger number of Anganwadis, this proposal is presented as a module with model strength of 25 Anganwadis. Parishad proposes to conduct one module for each District to begin with, there by covering 50 Anganwadis in the first year. Having worked with few Anganwadis in the mining belt over the last decade we feel confident about the desired outcomes. We hope that the Foundation will consider this proposal positively and give an opportunity to this Parishad to serve the community affected by mining - with a focus on the new generation - through active intervention in the most significant stage of education for long term benefit and sustainable development in the mining affected areas.

We look forward to have meaningful association with the Foundation in investing the expertise and the resources for fruitful results in the form of shaping the future of these areas. A detailed breakup of the financial proposal of the project is attached. Parishad representative will be glad to have a personal meeting in case of any queries and suggestion.

The learned Advocate General has tendered an affidavit filed on

behalf of the Director of Mines and Geology, placing on record the steps taken by the District Mineral Foundation in respect of the Sonshi and Pissurlem villages.

2. On the last occasion, we had expressed that the District Mineral Foundation must take proactive measures and carry out survey of the mining affected areas. This has not been done. It has been brought to our notice that in the month of May, there will be serious water shortage in the State. It will be, therefore, necessary that an immediate survey is carried out of the mining affected areas to ascertain whether the villages therein require any assistance in respect of drinking water.
3. Both the District Mineral Foundations consist of 5 to 6 members each. These members individually can lead teams consisting of Assistant Engineer, PWD and Talathi or Secretary of the Panchayat, with each teams. The District Mineral Foundations will demarcate areas, where such respective teams will carry out surveys and these teams will submit reports to the District Mineral Foundations. We expect that the teams would start taking surveys immediately and complete the same within one week from today. The learned Advocate General states that once the said reports are received and villages are earmarked as having shortage of water, immediately drinking water



will be provided through Water Tankers to these villages.

4. We have issued these directions because we have already expressed an opinion that the role of District Mineral Foundation is to take positive steps and not only act when complaints are received.

5. In view of the assurance given by the learned Advocate General, we defer the hearing of this petition to 5 June 2018.

6. We grant liberty to the parties to move the Vacation Court, if any urgent reliefs are required, in the intervening period.

7. The learned Advocate General states that in Fissurlem village, 175 Tankers 500 litres each will be provided daily.

Since 1957 there is compiling of rejection, murrum, clay from the operating mines with lease nos.22/50,38/51, 12/57 of Costi granted to M/S Chowgule & Co., erstwhile Mining Lease holder, Khandepar Tisk Usgao Goa, in this surrounding agricultural area of lakhs of sq. mtrs for the last 60 years. Till date not a single paisa is paid either by this mining company nor by the Government

Applicant states that there is water scarcity due to drainage of water below the sea level for extracting/winning iron ore from the Active Mining Operations at the cost of environment by polluting air, water, fertile soil and rendering this neighboring, surrounding agricultural area of lakhs of sq.m. as blemished, hackneyed, fruitless, infertile and non-agriculture land. Due to scarcity of water the agriculture is dying. No fresh water is available for drinking for human beings and animals as Nala, wells, springs are polluted and dried. As such the Surface Owner cannot use his property rendered infertile and the irreparable damage caused by the Respondent for beneficial use. The Applicant most respectfully submits and states that agricultural land means land devoted for agriculture and the land can be called non-agricultural land, if any activity in the nature of development, is carried over on the land which makes land unfit for cultivation. Here in this case M/S Chowgule & Co., erstwhile Mining Lease holder, with H.O. at Khandepar Usgao Tisk Goa, in the interest of Mineral Development had carried full-fledged mining operations for the last 60 years which made this land unfit for cultivation due to compiling of clay, murrum and scarcity of water. As such the plantation in the said area is dying & does not yield crop. So Applicant is entitled for Compensation under Provision of law.

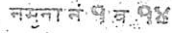

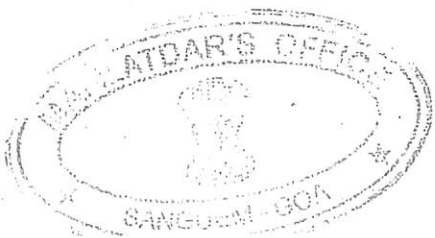

The Expert Committee submitted an Interim Report dated 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2014 to the Court after considering reports prepared by the Tata Energy Research Institute (TERI), New Delhi (1997); TERI and International Development Research Centre, Ottawa, Canada (2006); MoEF (2014); research papers prepared by the Goa University and the National Institute of Oceanography, Indian Institute of Technology (Indian School of Mines), Dhanbad (2013); Pollution Control Board, Goa (Annual Report) and other literature. It noted large-scale degradation of the environment in Goa due to mining operations. A Final Report was also submitted by the Expert Committee to the Court on or about 12<sup>th</sup> April, 2015 - it was obviously not available to the Court.

#### Other proceedings in the High Court

20. Quite independent of the cases pending in this Court, writ petitions were filed by several mining lease holders in the Bombay High Court praying either for consideration of their application for a second renewal of

that should be acted upon. Such a study should also take into account the impact of mining on the hydrology of the region and the extent of pollution caused to surface and ground water. This study should be compared to the earlier 10 years baseline data to determine the impact of mining on the biodiversity and hydrology of the area in the last decade. Based on the finding of this, a specific policy for mining of iron ore in the region may be developed. Such a policy along with a proper control and monitoring mechanism is necessary in order to avoid a situation such as the one under question. It would hopefully also ensure that mining in this region is carried out in accordance with best sectoral practices using appropriately clean technologies." [Emphasis supplied by us].

83. The report of the EAC reveals that there is not a single environment related or mining related law or legal requirement that was not violated by one or the other mining lease holder. Quite clearly, the rule of environmental law in Goa had gone with the wind.

84. There was one extremely important requirement relating to extraction of groundwater -- that is clearance from the Central Ground Water Board -- but even that was ignored. During the course of submissions, we were informed that there is plenty of groundwater available in Goa. However, what seems to have been overlooked is that with the intersection of groundwater levels with mining operations, the groundwater would get depleted much faster than expected or the quality of the groundwater would deteriorate. It is for this reason that MoEF insisted that clearance for drawal of groundwater must be taken from the Central Ground Water Board and

The Applicant respectfully highlights some of the observations noted from the Judgment dt. 7/2/2018 in case of Goa Foundation, observed by the Hon. Supreme Court like:

1. The thought of protecting and preserving the environment, concern for the fragile ecology of Goa was far from the thoughts of the stakeholders-Even the well-being of the average Goan was not taken into consideration by the stakeholders.
2. The iron ore was mined only for export mainly to China and to Japan. The prime beneficiary of this was of course the mining lease holder, a private entity, and the price was paid by the average Goan who had to suffer a polluted environment and witness the damage to the state's ecology. True this brought in considerable foreign exchange. But the larger benefit accrued to the private mining lease holder who obtained mining leases virtually free and without any social or welfare purpose, etc.
3. It did not serve the common/ public or social good but primarily assisted in filling the coffers of private entrepreneurs, particularly when it involves the natural resources.
4. The natural resources were exploited by mining lease holders for making profits and nothing else.
5. The mining lease holders had no element of social or public purpose, no concern for society and no regard for environment and the laws.
6. The Mining related law or legal requirements were violated by the lease holder. Quite clearly the rule of environmental law in Goa had gone with the wind.
7. The irreparable damage was being caused by the mining lease holder without any benefit to the villagers.
8. The Mining lease holders have made considerable profits in foreign through exports and might have also benefitted the foreign exchange reserves of the country, but the real-time damage to the quality of health and life of the average Goans and damage to the environment and the ecology of Goa is nevertheless incalculable or at least considerable and export benefits cannot be weighed against health or the environment.
9. What is unfortunate about the entire commercial activity of the mining lease holders is that there was no social or public purpose attached to the mining operations. There was one and only one objective behind the mining activity and that was profit maximization.
10. The mining lease holders violated virtually every applicable law or legal requirement it is clear that the rule of law was not their concern.
11. This has led to massive negative impacts on all ecosystems leading to enhanced air, water and soil pollution affecting quality of life across Goa. Mining lease holders were concerned with earning maximum profit and gave a complete go-bye to the concerns of the citizens.
12. It is the fundamental right of the people residing in mining area to have clean air and protection of the fragile ecology.
13. There was one extremely important requirement relating to extraction of groundwater that is clearance from the Central Ground Water Board but even that was ignored. Unfortunately no heed was paid to these requirements by the mining lease holder and not one mining lease holder has any clearance (where required) from the Central Ground Water Board.

The Applicant most respectfully submits and states that agricultural land means land devoted for agriculture and the land can be called non-agricultural land, if any activity in the nature of development, is carried over on the land which makes land unfit for cultivation. Here in this case M/S Chevgule & Co., erstwhile Mining Lease holder, with H.O. at Khandepar Usgao Tisk Goa, in the interest of Mineral Development had carried full-fledged mining operations for the last 60 years which made this land unfit for cultivation due to compiling of clay, murrum and scarcity of water. As such the plantation in the said area is dying & does not yield crop. So Applicant is entitled for Compensation under Provision of law.

The said land survey nos. 15/2,50/1, 15/3,15/13,24/1,24/2,53/0 of Costi Sanguern Taluka Goa with area 1,25,383 sq.mtrs. had been physically converted from agriculture land to non-agriculture land purpose by the Respondent by doing mining operations.

The Applicant states that for the aforesaid reason the Applicant is not and shall never be in a position to use his own said land for cultivation /agriculture purpose in future. Thus depriving me from my property, livelihood, bread & butter

As such the Applicant is entitled to get Compensation from the mineral foundation as claimed under law.



Subject: Scarcity of drinking water faced by villagers.

Respected Sir,

We, the villagers of Maina, falling under Village Panchayat, Caurem-Pirla of Quepem Taluka (Sanguem Constituency), would like to bring to your kind notice, the problem of water shortage faced by us.

At present we face severe problem of water shortage and severity was added to it by the operations of certain mining companies in the village. Several times we humbly requested concerned companies but they turned deaf ear to our humble appeal. Water of springs being drained into hollow deeps created by mining excavations and the same is pumped out heavily by them thereby wasting such a huge quantity of water without channelizing it for sustainable use.

Our village has enough additional water resources but need to be channelized properly in the urbanized location. When mining companies turned deaf ear to our genuine problem, we banged the doors of Public Work Department and requested to improve the water supply to counter the harshness faced by us.

In response to our request, Public Work Department made estimate of improvement of water supply from one of the spring of our village, possessing ample water, however it was informed that no contractor has been moved to accept the tender of that work even after four times putting that work to tender.

After waiting for considerable time, we requested Public work Department to atleast renovate/desilt and re-activate one well which was constructed by the Government Authorities and connected to water tank earlier, that supplied water to

villagers but was abandoned later due to some reasons. However, here too it was found that estimate of renovation was made by Public Works Department but no contractor was turned out to accept the work.

Supplying drinking water to citizens is of prime important and vital work, however it has been left to the mercy of contractors. In this context, it is felt that such type of typical works connected to public life should not be left to the will of contractors.

In view of above, we humbly request your goodself to kindly come out with certain solutions to execute works which are not accepted by contractors through separate Government agency, on the basis of Goa Infra structure Development Corporation.












