At the outset of the meeting the Collector (North Goa) welcomed all the officials.

Agenda Item No. 1:

Transportation of School going children from Ovaliye village, Sattari, North Goa.

The Member Secretary inquired with the General Manager, Kadamba Transport Corporation Ltd. regarding the availability of buses in the area. The General Manager, Kadamba Transport Corporation Ltd. replied that they have to verify the status of availability of buses and routes in the area.

The Dy. Director, North Education Zone, Directorate of Education, stated that the Balrath for Pissurlem School if possible can be diverted through Ovaliye village. The Dy. Director, North Education Zone later also inquired with the Head Master Pissurlem High School and told that already a Balrath has been collecting the school going children from Ovaliye area and taking them to Pissurlem High School. He also made a mention that the names and other details of the 3 children which require transportation facility for going to school from Ovaliye area to Pissurlem needs be obtained from the Goa Foundation which can be verified by the Education Department.

The Member Secretary informed the Collector (North Goa) that a meeting may be called to decide with regards to transportation facility to School going Children for next academic year.

She also informed the Collector (North Goa) about the functioning of the DMF in other states and mentioned that a training either by the Centre for Science and Environment (CEC), New Delhi or by District Mineral Foundation, Officials of other states like Gujarat or Chhatisgarh need to be conducted so as to train the Government Officials from the different taluka regarding the DMF functioning. The Collector North Goa agreed regarding the same.

The Member Secretary also briefed the Collector (North Goa) regarding the application for transportation facility for school going children are decided based on the availability of school in the vicinity of the village. The DMF North Goa has provided school bus facility in Sonshi and Honda Village areas.

The Member Secretary informed the Collector (North Goa) that a five year plan needs to be developed based on which an annual plan and an annual budget can be prepared for which the Department of Planning and Statistics and Finance Department is required to play an active role for preparation of the budget.

The Collector (North Goa) mentioned that the possibility of providing funds to Kadamba transport Corporation Ltd. for purchase of buses for providing transportation facility to School going children can be examined.
