In exercise of the powers conferred by section 23C of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 (Central Act 67 of 1957) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Goa hereby makes the following rules, so as to further amend the Goa (Prevention of Illegal Mining, Storage and Transportation of Minerals) Rules, 2013, namely:—

- 1. Short title and commencement.— (1) These rules may be called the Goa (Prevention of Illegal Mining, Storage and Transportation of Minerals) (Sixth Amendment) Rules, 2024.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Amendment of Rule 2.— In rule 2 of the Goa (Prevention of Illegal Mining, Storage and Transportation of Minerals) Rules, 2013

(hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Rules"), in sub-rule (1), after clause (ze), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:—

- (Zee) 'State license': means a license issued by the Authorized Officer to any person, Firm or Company who wishes to engage in trading activity, import, export, storage or otherwise deal with any mineral in the State under rule 45 of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.
- 3. *Insertion of new rule 6A.* In the principal rules, after rule 6, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:—
 - 6A. Granting of State License: (1) The holder of a mining lease, or any person or firm or company engaged in trading or storage or end-use or export of minerals mined in the country shall apply for grant of State License in Form A, in online mode on the Directorate of Mines & Geology website enclosing documents i.e. Pancard, Aadhar card, Memorandum of Articles of Association for company, Partnership Deed in case of Firm, Certificate of Incorporation for company, Importer/Exporter Code Certificate, GST Certificate, Police Clearance Certificate of the applicant from his Native State, IBM Registration Certificate issued by Indian Bureau of Mines (excluding New Registration) etc., hereto along with licence fees of Rs. 50,000/-. A individual/company/proprietor/firm should be granted only single registration of State License.

The Authorized Officer will check the validity of documents enclosed with the application in Form A. The documents to

be enclosed in Form A are indicated in aforesaid Form.

The Authorized Officer can refuse the application for grant of "State Licence" if the applicant does not comply with the required conditions as per the Form A or has submitted the incomplete application. The Order of refusal/rejection can be passed by the Authorized Officer giving reasons for refusal/rejection.

- (2) The Authorized Officer may after being satisfied grant State License in Form B hereto within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of the application, subject to such terms and conditions as decided by the Authorized Officer.
- (3) Application for Revision— Any person aggrieved by an order of the Authorized Officer made under these rules, may, within two months from the date of the communication of such Order to him, apply to the Secretary (Mines) with application fees of Rs. 1,000/- for revision of such Order. Provided that any such application may be entertained after the said period of two months if the applicant satisfies the Government that he had sufficient cause for not making the application within the time.

Upon receipt of such applications, the Revision Authority may call for the records of the case and the comments of the Authorized Officer and after hearing the petitioner, may confirm, modify or set aside the Order or pass such Order in relation thereto, as it may deem just and proper. Pending the final disposal of an application

for revision, the Revision Authority may, for sufficient cause, stay the execution of the order against which the revision application has been made.

- (4) The existing lease holders/traders//exporters/end users who have obtained the registration number from Indian Bureau of Mines under rule 45 of MCDR, 1988 and MCDR, 2017 shall obtain the State License within a period of 90 days from the date of commencement of the Goa (Prevention of Illegal Mining, Storage and Transportation of Minerals) (Sixth Amendment) Rules, 2024, by paying a fee of Rs. 5,000/- failing which the login credentials on Bhumija portal shall be deactivated till the State License is obtained.
