Sub: Regarding regulation of Transportation of mineral ore.

Since new mining season is about to begin and it is important to regulate the transportation of ore so as to maintain a proper account of ore for computation of royalty and other dues payable to the Government. So also to ensure that the mining transport is regulated through respective lease holders/traders irrespective of the fact whether the transportation of ore is carried by lease holders/traders directly or otherwise.

The following shall be implemented w.e.f. 15th August 2012 onwards for strict compliance failing which the respective lease holders/traders shall be held responsible for such irregularities.

- 1. Every lease holder shall install electronic weigh bridge with necessary software to generate transit pass/permits as specified by Director of Mines & Geology.
- 2. The weigh bridge shall be caliberated before commencement of next season through Competent Authority.
- 3. The weigh bridge shall generate permits/passes having details like T.C.No., Vehicle No., Destination, Quantity of Ore and such other details as specified by Director of Mines & Geology.
- 4. The weigh bridge shall be programmed in such a manner that no passes/slips etc. shall be generated for quantities above carrying capacity of any carrier/vehicle.
- 5. There shall be no overloading by carrier/vehicle above carrying capacity.
- 6. A copy of Permit/Pass generated at weigh bridge shall be displayed on the carrier/vehicle by pasting the same on the windshield.

- 7. The Driver driving the carrier/vehicle shall have commercial batch issued by Department of Transport, Government of Goa. The drivers shall not drive the vehicles in rash and negligent manner and shall obey traffic rules.
- 8. Proper safeguard shall be taken to avoid dust pollution, including covering the vehicles with Tarpulin.
- 9. There shall be adherence to the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and Hon'ble High Court and other authorities of Government.
- 10. If overloading of carrier/vehicle is found a fine of Rs. 5,00000/- per vehicle shall be imposed which shall be recovered from the respective lease holder/trader.
- 11. If overloading of 25 or more carrier/trucks is found from any lease hold area, the proposal shall be moved to the Government for termination of lease of the lease holder.
- 12. The practice of submission of Daily Report of transportation shall invariably be continued on Departments Email ID: dmg.goa.report@gmail.com not latter than the next day of transportation of ore till the new website is operational with an interface with lease holder/trader for real time data collection.
