In exercise of the powers conferred by section 15 of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 (Central Act 67 of 1957), and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Goa hereby makes the following rules so as to further amend the Goa, Daman and Diu Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 1985 as follows namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Goa Minor Mineral Concession (Amendment) Rules, 2004.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of rule 2.*— In rule 2 of the Goa, Daman and Diu Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 1985,

(i) for clause (b), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:—

“(b) “Competent Officer” means the Director of Mines, Government of Goa.”

(ii) for clause (e), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:—

“(e) “Inspecting Officer” means the Senior Geologist, or the Senior Technical Assistant or the Assistant Geologist or the Technical Assistant in the Directorate of Mines or any other Officer authorised by the Government to exercise all or such of the powers of the Inspecting Officer as the Government may specify.”.
